

SAFEGUARDING: SAFER SLEEP WEEK MONDAY 11TH MARCH – SUNDAY 17TH MARCH

The theme for this year's Safer Sleep Week campaign is the safest place.

Safer Sleep Week is The Lullaby Trust's national awareness campaign targeting anyone looking after a young baby. It aims to raise awareness of sudden infant death syndrome (SIDS) and the simple advice that reduces the risk of it occurring. We know that greater awareness of safer sleep leads to a

decrease in the numbers of babies dying.

This campaign will show parents and carers the simplest way to create a safe sleep space for their baby that will help to protect their vulnerable airway and reduce the risk of SIDS and accidents.
