SWIMMING




Due to circumstances out of our control, the 'pop up' pool located at Mere Green Primary School will no longer be used for our swimming

Although serious vision problems during childhood are rare, routine eye checks are offered to newborn babies and young children to identify any problems early on.




Vision Screening will take place for our Reception children on Thursday 2nd May. If you would like more information regarding the checks that will take place, please follow the NHS link below.

The single biggest predictor of high academic achievement is reading to children.


