



NEW BUILD TEMPORARY ARRANGMENTS

As part of our ongoing commitment to keeping you informed about school matters, we wrote to you in May advising you that construction work on the new school build will be commencing during May half term. We are reminding you of the following temporary Arrangements for Dropping Children to School and Collecting during Building Work.



School Drop off.

- ALL CHILDREN in Reception, Year One and Year Two should be directed into school through the Reception Playground gate. We would ask that you say goodbye to them at the gate where they can then make their way straight into their classroom.
- All CHILDREN in Year Three, Year Four, Year Five and Year Six should make their way into school via the Key Stage Two front door, where they can make their way to class.

Collection for KS1 Children

- Reception: All reception children will be dismissed from their playground gate, leading onto the school car-park.
- Year 1; Year 1 children will be dismissed through the school's main entrance directly to parents.
- Year 2; Children in Year 2 will be dismissed through the green gate next to the Nursery building directly to parents.

Collection of KS2 Children

- Year 3; Year 3 children will be dismissed directly from their classrooms onto the patio in front of their classroom doors
- Year 4; children will be dismissed via the Reception playground gate onto the carpark.
- Year 5 and 6; Children will be dismissed through the KS2 building Front doors.
