SAFEGUARDING; SUN PROTECTION

A huge thank you to one of our parents who visited us today to extend our learning. The children in Reception LOVED sitting in the fire engine and spraying the hose!

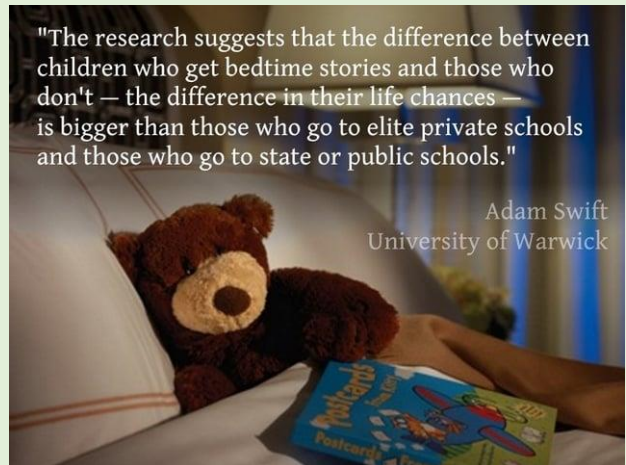
