Key Question Week 1: What happened to the big bad wolf?

Key Text for Linked Learning: The Three Little Pigs

This half term the children will be learning all about the different traditional tales. We will be starting off the Spring term with The Three Little Pigs.

PSED: Children will be exploring what kindess means. They will be discussing times that they have been kind and thinking of ways the wolf could be kind to the three little pigs. They will be encouraged to take into account what others say.

Communication and Language:

Children will be exploring the meaning and and sounds of new words. They will be acting out the narrative of the Three Little Pigs in play situations.

Physical Development: In Physical Development this week, the children will be developing their underarm throw. They will start by throwing bean bags at targets. The children will continue focusing on the correct formation of letters and encouraged to use the correct pencil grip.

Literacy:

In phonics this week, the children will be learning the new sounds **j**, **v**, **w** and **x**. The children will be learning to read and write the tricky words **he** and **she**.

The children will be consolidating their cvc reading knowledge by reading simple captions and matching to the correct picture to demonstrate an understanding e.g. the pig is sad. The children will be sequencing the story of the Three Little Pigs, discussing the characters and creating a story map as a whole class.

Mathematics: In Number, the children will be learning about the numeral 8. The numberblock 8 will be introduced to them and they'll be representing 8 in different ways e.g numicon, cubes, fingers, tens frame (same value, different appearance). They'll be looking at what numbers make 8 and how the numeral 8 looks.

In Shape, Space and Measure, the children will be using familiar objects and common shapes to continue and create repeated patterns.

Understanding of the World:

Children will be looking at their own and others homes and discussing the similarities and differences. They'll be exploring materials and why the brick house was the strongest. This week, they will be completing a science investigation where they will predict if the material would survive a huge blow from the big bad wolf.

Expressive Arts and Design:

Children will be playing alongside others to act out the narractive of the Three Little Pigs. They will be using a range of materials to create representations of houses and the pigs.


Vocabulary:

The children will be exposed to this vocabulary this week. They will learn the meaning of these words too.







This week we will be beginning to look at phase 3 phonemes.

The phonemes we are focusing on this week are w,v,j and x. Can you think of any more words that begin with these sounds?











Three Little Pig Story Sequencing









