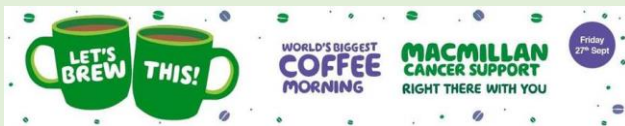

LEARNING FUTURES Q & A

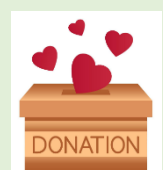
